SUBJECT: Environmental Management Policy (version 2)

1. Background. Executive Order 13148, Greening the Government Through Leadership in Environmental Management, requires USAG-S to develop and implement an Environmental Management System by 31 December 2005.

2. Purpose. This policy will be the cornerstone of the USAG-S Environmental Management System to ensure that strategies are established to support environmental leadership programs, policies, and procedures and ensure that USAG-S senior level managers explicitly and actively endorse these strategies.

3. Applicability. This policy applies to each Organization at USAG-S whose operation has an environmental aspect as determined under an Environmental Management System.

-Communicate information on our proactive environmental initiatives to interested parties and the general public; and,
